Crossroads Child Development Center

The Crossroads Child Development Center is a multi disciplinary early intervention and education program that is integrated within the culturally proficient behavioral health care system of the Chaney Allen Women's Program at The Crossroads Center.



The Child Development Program

The Child Development Program provides onsite childcare and early intervention services to young children (ages 0-5) of mothers enrolled in residential or outpatient treatment at the Chaney Allen Women's Services program. The program is open Monday through Friday, 6:00 am - 6:00 pm. There are separate classrooms for infants, toddlers and preschoolers, furnished with developmentally appropriate equipment and materials.

The Child Development Program is licensed by the State of Ohio Childcare Licensing Department of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.
